Forgiveness is greater than justice. Justice is human; forgiveness is divine. 寬恕大過公正。公正是屬人性, 寬恕是屬神性。






Without forgiveness, life is governed by an endless cycle of resentment and retaliation.

沒有寬恕,生命會被一個無止盡的怨恨和報復 之循環所操控。










He that cannot forgive others breaks the bridge over which he must pass himself; for every man has need to be forgiven.
