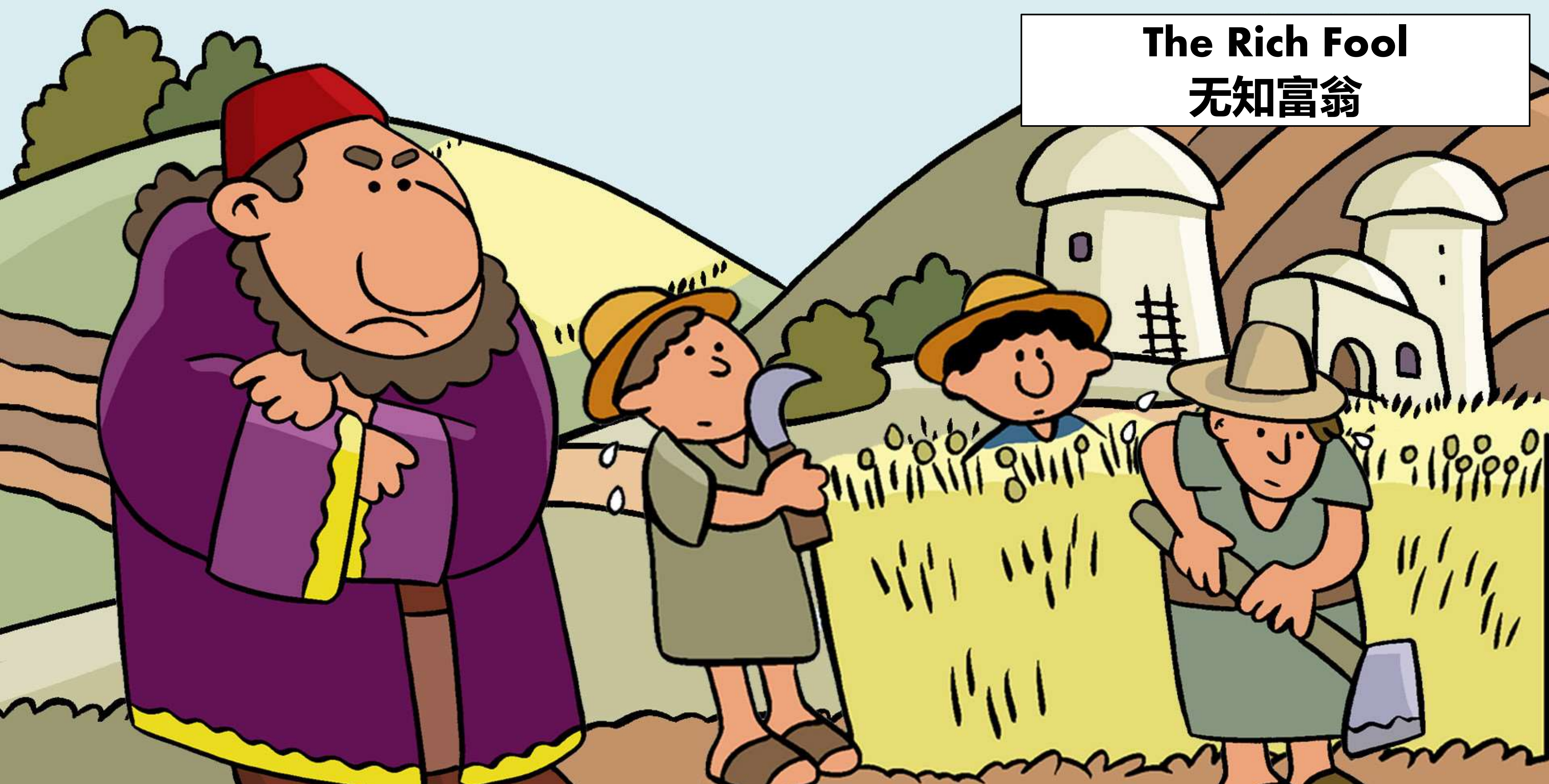


The Rich Fool 无知富翁

那时，我就可以对自己说，“你积存这么多财产，一生享用不尽，现在大可高枕无忧、尽情地吃喝玩乐吧！”

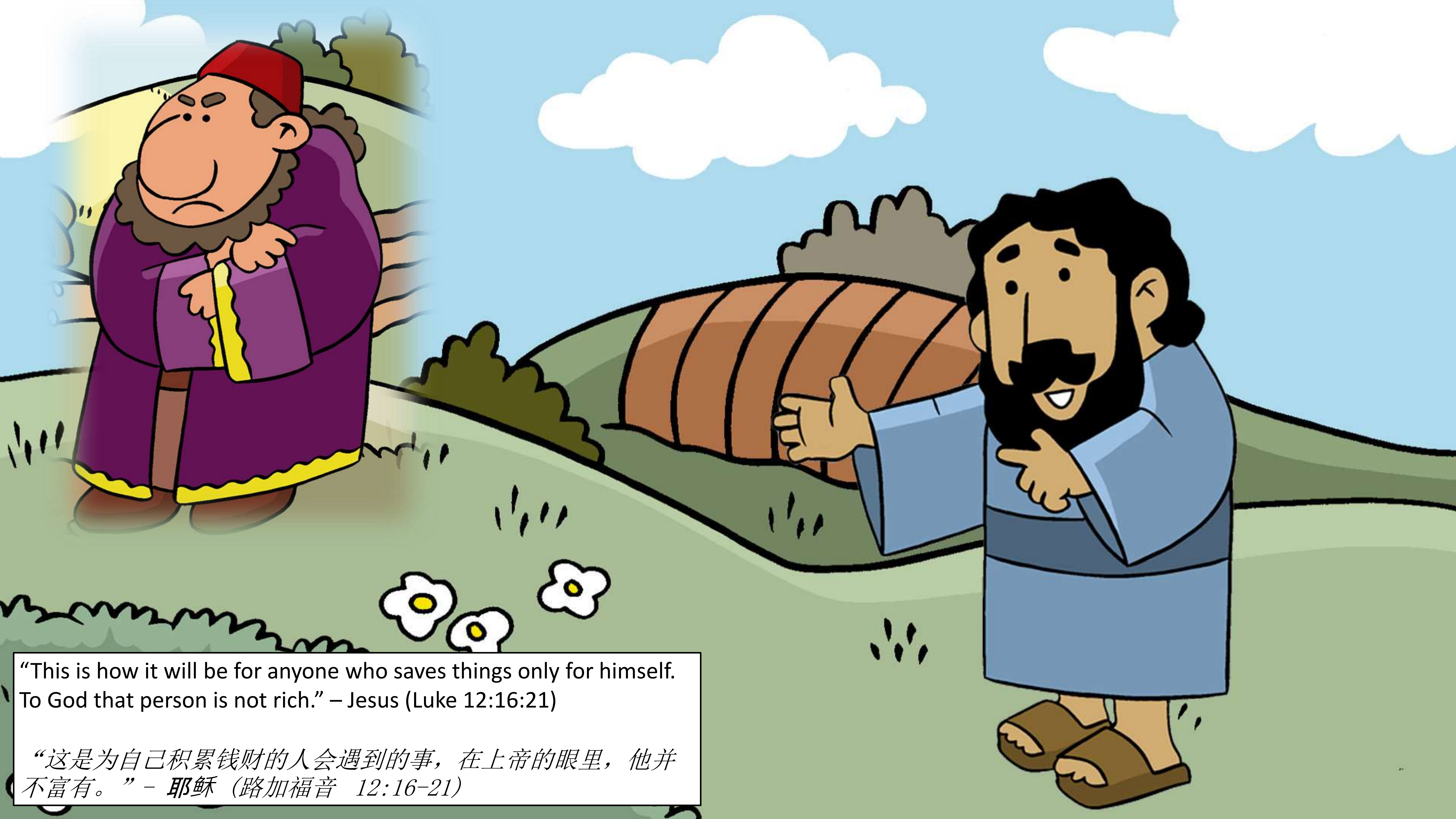


"But God said to him,
