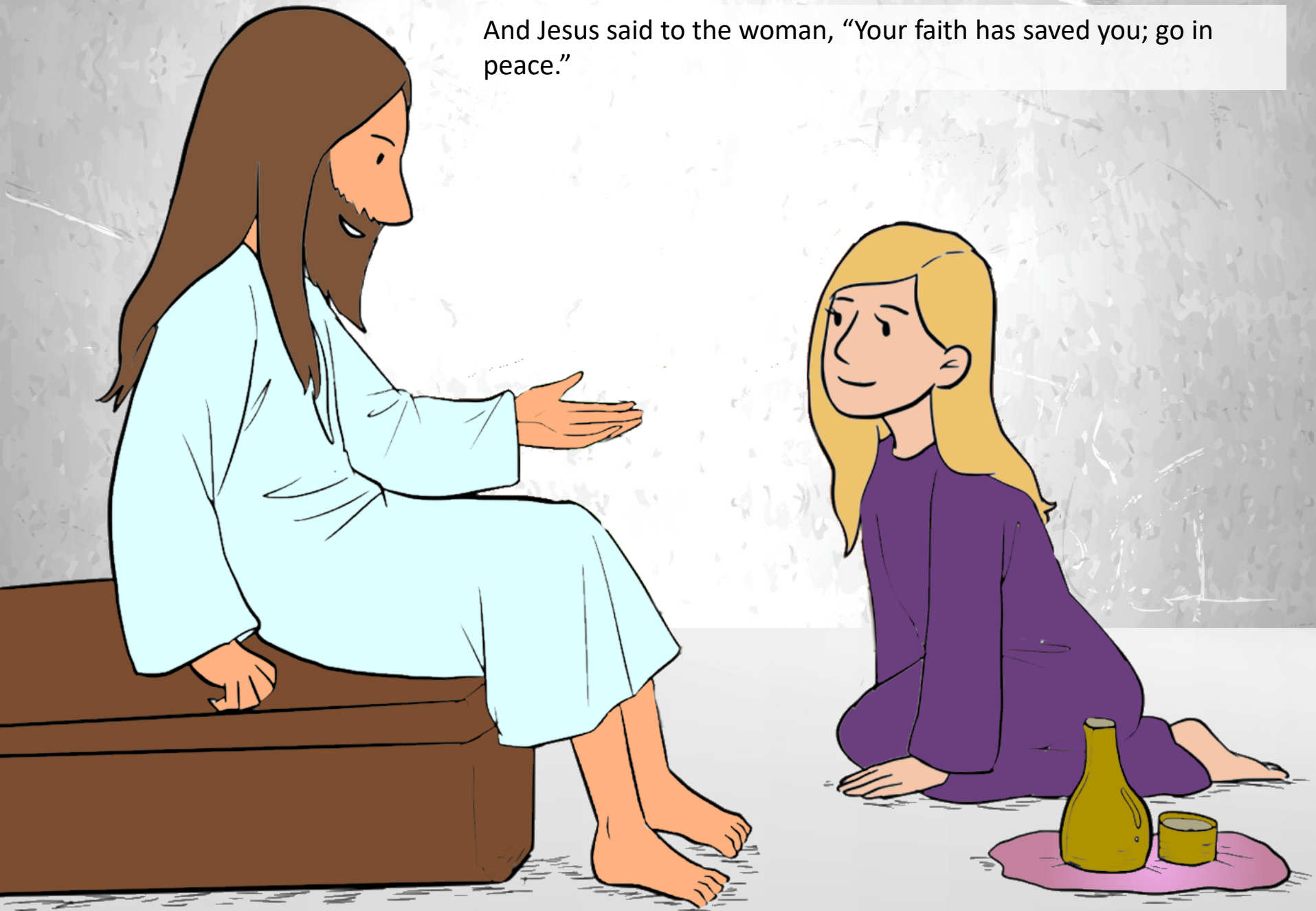
Simon answered, “I think it would be the one who owed him the most money.”
