amado*



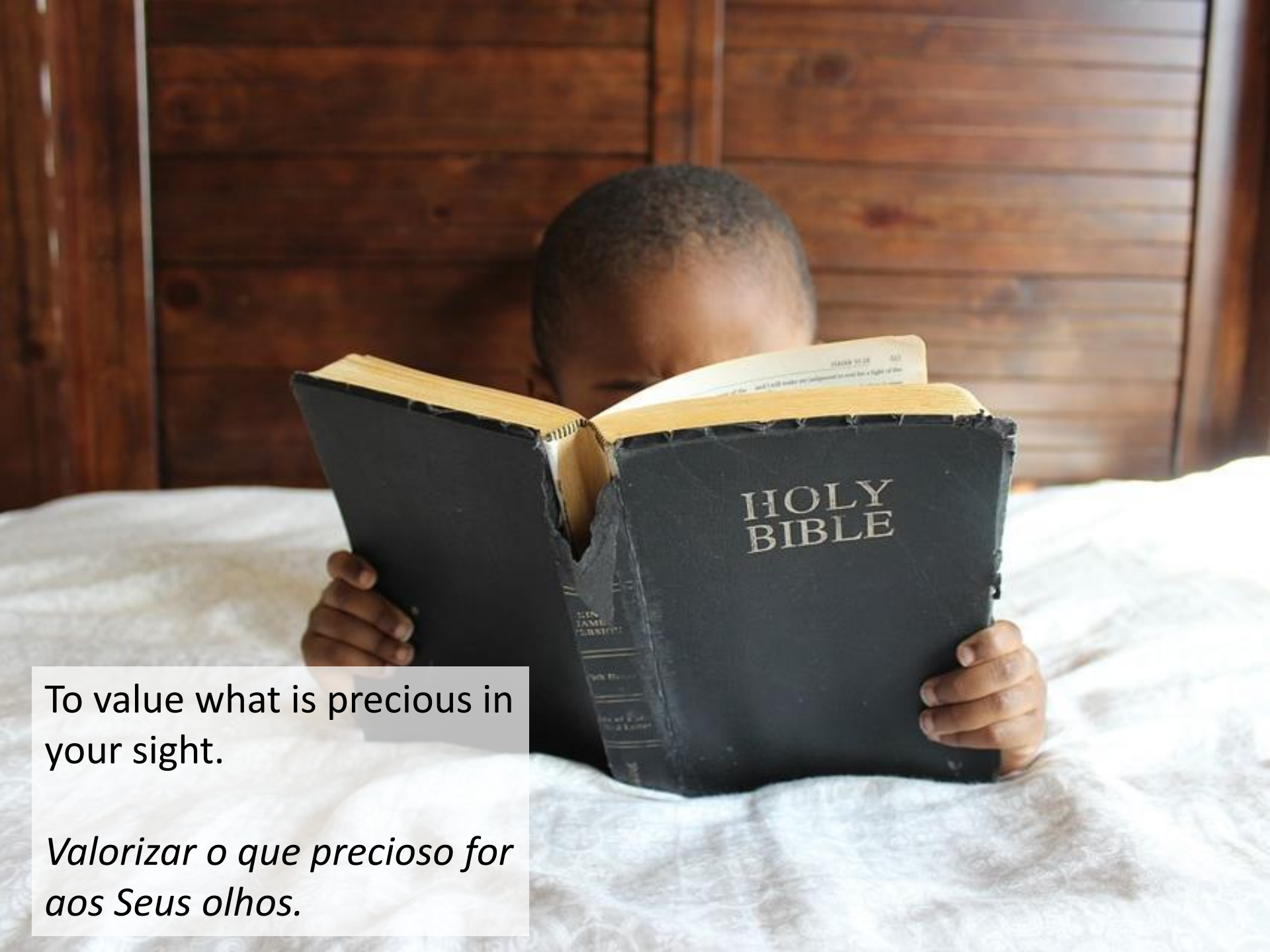


To praise what delights you most,
