



Courage at Work

Bible Passages on Courage for Children



Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me. Your rod and your staff protect and comfort me. (Joshua 1:9, Isaiah 59:19, Psalm 23:4)

Do not be afraid, for I have ransomed you. I have called you by name; you are mine. When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you. For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. From eternity to eternity I am God. No one can snatch anyone out of my hand. No one can undo what I have done. (Isaiah 43:1-3, 13)



Be strong and courageous, and do the work. Don't be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD God, my God, is with you. He will not fail you or forsake you.

Be on guard. Stand firm in the faith. Be courageous. Be strong. And do everything with love. Remain in fellowship with Christ so that when he returns, you will be full of courage and not shrink back from him in shame. (1 Chronicles 28:20, 1 Corinthians 16:13-14, 1 John 2:28)





Prepare your heart and lift up your hands to him in prayer! Get rid of your sins, and leave all iniquity behind you. Then you will lift up your face. You will be strong and free of fear. You will forget your trouble; it will be like water flowing away.

Your life will be brighter than the noonday. Even darkness will be as bright as morning. Having hope will give you courage. You will be protected and will rest in safety. (Job 11:13-18)
