*Bible Passages on God's Word for Children*



Great blessings belong to those who don't listen to evil advice...Instead, they love the Lord's teachings and think about them day and night. They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.

(James 1:22-25)
