## O sonho de Jacó

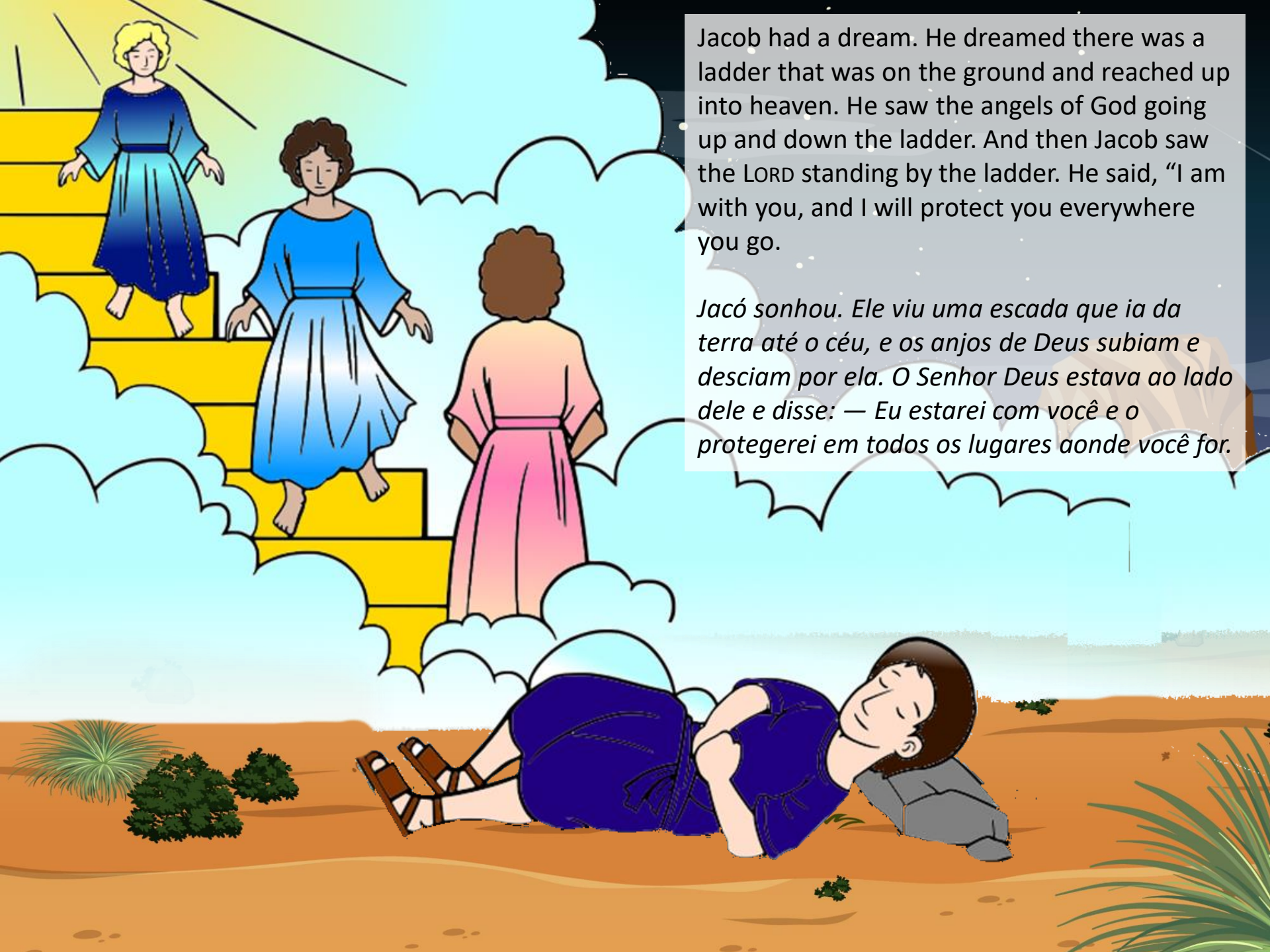
Jacó partiu de Berseba e foi para Harã.
